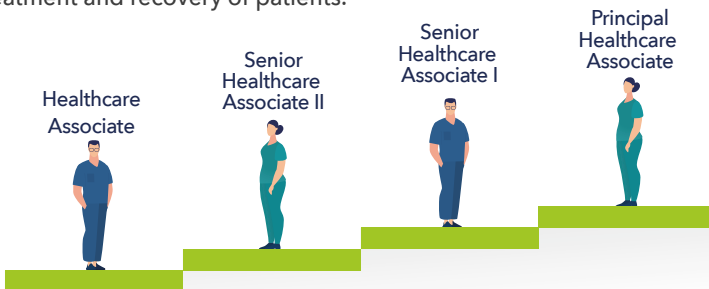
PATIENT SERVICE ASSOCIATE

This role involves patient services, such as patient registration, appointment scheduling, payment, financial counselling and administrative duties. For some settings, you will have the opportunity to assist clinicians during consultations and perform clinically related duties (i.e., phlebotomy, visual acuity, etc.).



HEALTHCARE ASSOCIATE

As a member of the healthcare professional team, you will provide personal care and clinical monitoring to patients to ensure that they are safe and comfortable during their stay at the hospital. You will perform basic tests and nursing procedures that contribute to the treatment and recovery of patients.

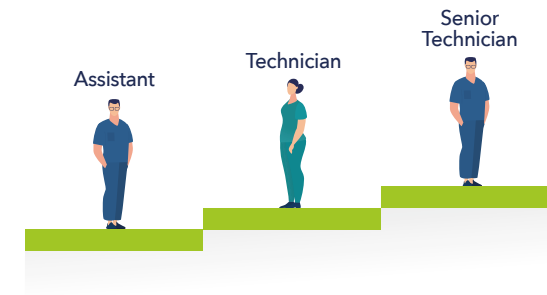


OPERATING THEATRE ASSISTANT

As a member of the operating theatre team, you will contribute to ensuring good outcomes from surgeries. You will prepare the operating room, including the equipment, and assist surgeons and nurses with positioning patients on the operating table.

CENTRAL STERILE SUPPLY ASSISTANT

As a member of the Central Sterile Supply Department, you will clean, prepare, pack and sterilise instruments and consumables. You will also fulfil the sterile material requirements of various departments, including the Operating Theatre, the Emergency Department, and the wards and clinics.
